

European Union Regulation Compliance Statement
Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and restriction of
Chemicals (REACH)

Airtronics supports the underlying goals of REACH, which are consistent with our own health and safety commitment to promote the responsible manufacturing, use and handling of chemicals.

Airtronics will meet all REACH requirements and is committed to providing customers with information about substances in our products according to REACH requirements.

Based on review of information provided by our raw material suppliers, Airtronics can report that our products and parts **do not** contain above the 0.1% weight (w/w) threshold of any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC)) as defined in Article 33 (1) & (2) “Substances of Very High Concern” EC Title VII, Chapter 1 Article 57 and revised as of March 30 2010

Airtronics will work with its suppliers to ensure that all Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) are reported to the European Chemicals Agency, if necessary, and communicated to customers in compliance with the REACH requirements. Airtronics will continue to monitor the REACH regulations for any new Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) that may be included in subsequent ECHA candidate lists. Airtronics will compare any newly listed SVHC with the raw materials in our finished products and communicate this information to our customers.
